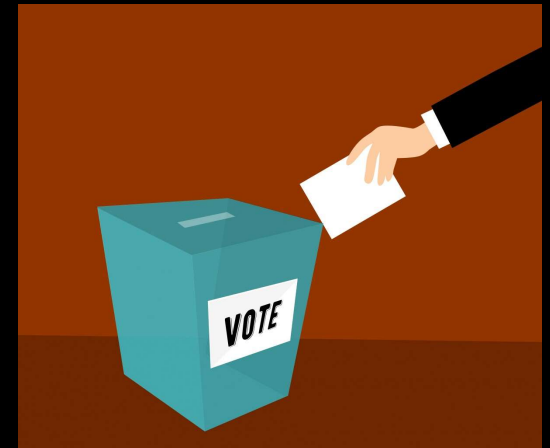
TCA and Computer Information Program
