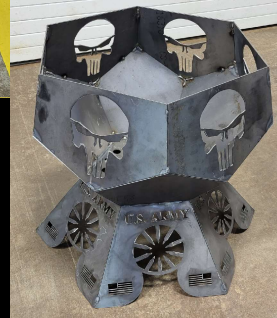
- 18-month process of workshops, trainings, and a mentorship connection
