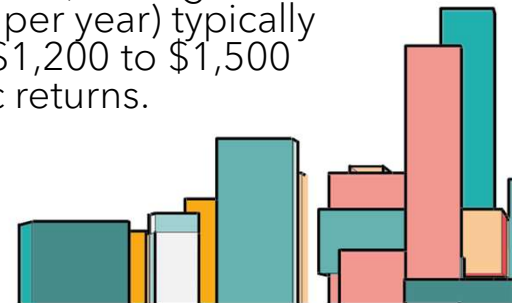
- 208 returns completed (\$83,200)

2024 US Accounting and Tax Pricing Benchmark Report by Ignition.

Almost half (49%) of tax firms charge \$400 to \$799 for personal tax returns.

Around 17% of firms charge less than \$400 (a rare find).

Large firms (making \$1.4M+ per year) typically charge \$1,200 to \$1,500 for basic returns.

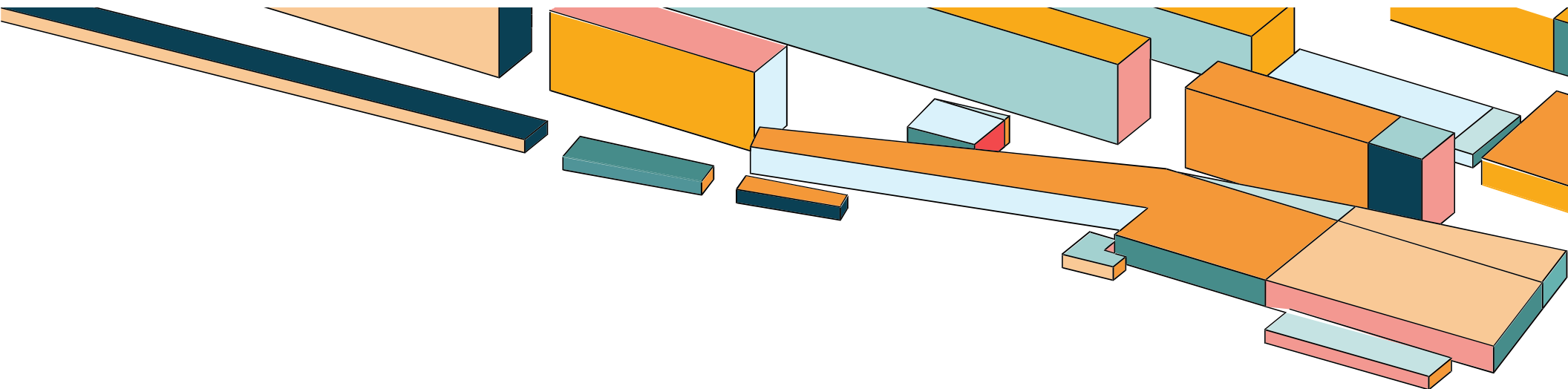
